American Lager: Massproduced, inexpensive, aimed at the broadest possible demographic. Relatively "weak" in flavor, this style beer is popular at parties and gatherings. (Yuengling)



American Pale Ale: Amber in color, a pronounced and strong hoppy flavor/aroma. Often the perfect balance between malt and hops. Sierra Nevada is the best-selling American pale ale in the US.



Belgian Wheat: Originating in the Middle Ages, brewed with wheat and barley. With hints of coriander and orange peel, this beer is perfect for summer, with a refreshing and drinkable finish. (Blue Moon)



Bock: Originating in Germany, hearty beer, high alcohol content. This beer has a pronounced malt flavor with just enough hop bitterness to tame the sweetness. (Shiner)



India Pale Ale: Originally made to withstand (brewed with extra hops) the voyage from England to India: very hoppy aroma/flavor; higher alcohol content. Flying Dog is based in Frederick, Maryland. (Flying Dog Snake Dog)



Pilsner: The world's most popular style of beer. The first light-colored beer, this style of beer is malty-sweet and drinks well due to its clean and crisp finish. (Beck's)
